



## Hale Ramey

July 8, 1927 - October 27, 2016

Hale H. Ramey, age 89 of Athens, AL, formerly of Eddyville, KY, died at 10:15 pm Thursday, October 27, 2016 at Athens Health and Rehabilitation Center in Athens, AL. He was a member of Athens First Baptist Church and a nine year veteran of the U. S. Army while serving two tours of duty in Korea in the 50's. He was preceded in death by one brother A. C. Ramey and two sisters Virginia Bell Glass and Mary Smith. His parents were Avery C. Sr. and Thelma Holloway Ramey. Survivors include his wife of 65 years Shirley Crisp Ramey of Athens, Al, two sons Paul Ramey of Sweeney, TX, Mark Ramey of Little Rock, AR, one daughter Cynthia Patton of Athens, AL, five grandchildren, four great grandchildren, two brothers Tony Ramey of Eddyville, H. C. Beck of Princeton, three sisters Ethel Faulkner of Eddyville, Linda Williamson of Princeton and Ann Dunning of Eddyville. Mr. Ramey was a chemical operator at Pennwalt Chemical Co. in Calvert City, KY until retirement then was a full time school bus driver for Lyon County School System, helped organize the ambulance service for Eddyville and Lyon County, was the Captain of the Lyon County Rescue Squad and was chief of Eddyville's Volunteer Fire Department for 30 years, was on the Rolling Hills Cemetery Board when it was formed and served on the Lyon Co. Port Authority Board and a former member of the Lions Club in Lyon County. In 1974 Mr. Ramey was honored as Eddyville's Citizen of the year and was honored as a Kentucky Colonel in 2002.
