Hazel Gurley Demery, age 98, passed away Tuesday January 26, 2021 at Christian Care Center of Kuttawa. She was born September 20, 1922 in Lexington Tennessee, Henderson County to the late Marshall and Effie Gurley on the Gurley farm. Her family moved to Blythville Arkansas in 1936, Mississippi County. She was a graduate of the Old Blythville City Hospital School of Nursing with a diploma on March 1, 1941. During her nursing career she worked in Arkansas, Tennessee, Madisonville Kentucky, Hartford Kentucky and Owensboro Kentucky, Dr. M. H. Mosey in Old Eddyville Ky., Dr. England in Grand Rivers, Ky. She was industrial nurse for Reed Crushed Stone and Vulcan Materials Co. for 58 years. She retired at the age of 85. She enjoyed being active in the community affairs, she was Red Cross bloodmobile Chairman for Livingston Co. for over 60 years. She was a member of the Nashville Tennessee Red Cross blood Program Board. She was a Kentucky Colonel and a Dutchess of Paducah. She was a member of Calvert City Church of Christ.
