



Mary Parrent Williamson

February 1, 1918 - July 13, 2012

Mary Parrent Williamson, age 94 of Eddyville, died at 10:20 pm Friday, July 13, 2012 at River's Bend Retirement Community in Kuttawa. Mrs. Williamson's home in Eddyville was the second house built when Eddyville and Kuttawa had to be relocated as the result of Lake Barkley being impounded. They moved in before all of the public utilities were in place. She was a member of Saratoga United Methodist Church and was also active in Eddyville United Methodist Church. She was also a member of the Starlight Chapter of the Eastern Star in Eddyville and was preceded in death by her husband Ollie Williamson in 1986, five brothers Earl Parrent, Talmadge Parrent, Paul Parrent, Henry Parrent, Alben Parrent and one sister Beatrice Parrent. Her parents were Dave and Odie Lamb Parrent. Survivors include one sister Mollie Yates of Eddyville, two nieces Lilburn Ann Denney of Eddyville Jeannine Huber of Nashville, two nephews Glenn Parrent of Wichita, KS, Charles Parrent of Kuttawa, 4 great nieces, including Libby George of Princeton, three great nephews including Jay Cannon of Eddyville and several great great nieces and nephews.
