



Noble William Choat

March 8, 1923 - June 15, 2014

Noble Choat, age 91 of Eddyville, died at 5:35 am Sunday, June 15, 2014 at his home in Eddyville. He was a member of Eddyville First Baptist Church, a 63 year member and past master of Joppa Masonic Lodge #167 in Eddyville and a U S Army veteran of WW II where he received the Purple Heart. Mr. Choat had retired as a lock operator at Kentucky Dam for the U S Corps of Engineers, the owner and operator of Choat's Pool Room in Eddyville from 1971 until 1980 and had been a Councilman for the City of Eddyville. Mr. Choat was preceded in death in 2006 by his wife of 59 years Anne Choat and one brother Marlin Choat. His parents were Remus and Sally Dunning Choat. Survivors include five sons, Stanley Choat of Memphis, TN, Mike Choat of Granbury, TX, Lindell Choat of Eddyville, David Choat of Benton, John Choat of Eddyville, thirteen grandchildren, twenty great grandchildren and one sister Margaret Dunn of Calvert City, KY. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 pm Wednesday, June 18, 2014 at Dunn's Funeral Home in Eddyville with Rev.
