



## Robert James Grubbs

February 13, 1923 - March 25, 2015

Robert James Grubbs, age 92 of Kuttawa/Princeton, died at 12:25 am Wednesday, March 25, 2015 at Rivers Bend Retirement Community in Kuttawa. He was a member of Fairview United Methodist Church in Eddyville, a lifetime member of the VFW, a member of the American Legion and the Lyon County Lions Club. After serving in WW II he was honorably discharged and became a prison official at Kentucky State Penitentiary in Eddyville then at the California Men's Colony in San Louis Obispo, CA until retirement in 1996 with 45 years of total service. He was preceded in death by his daughter Loretta J. Boswell in 2006, one brother Paul Grubbs, two sisters Lois Mitchell and Ruth Galusha. His parents were Robert and Allie Saylor Grubbs. Survivors include one sister Goldia Parish of Eddyville, two grandchildren Jamie Boswell of Princeton, Gay Ann George of Plainfield, IL and one great granddaughter Allie Paige George of Plainfield, IL.
