August 3, 1943 - October 21, 2022

Roy L. Aldridge, age 79 of Eddyville, formerly of Between the Rivers, died at 2:52 pm Friday, October 21, 2022 at the Ray & Kay Eckstein Hospice Center in Paducah. He was a member of Kuttawa First Baptist Church, a 50 year member of the Villa Park Masonic Lodge #1113 and had retired as the Crew Chief of Fleet Service for American Air Lines. Roy was preceded in death by one son Dr. Roy Lee Aldridge Jr, his wife Stacy still survives, and his parents Dick and Lavada Forsythe Aldridge.
