



Dr. Terry L. Calhoun

May 6, 1949 - April 4, 2022

Dr. Terry L. Calhoun, age 72 of Kuttawa, formerly of Between the Rivers, died at 1:55 pm Monday, April 4, 2022 at Jefferson County Memorial in Jefferson City, TN. He was a member of Macedonia Baptist Church and had retired from the Veterans Administration Clinic in Paducah in 2019. Dr. Calhoun had been a practicing physician in Missouri and then Kentucky for years. He was preceded in death by his parents Terry Ney and Loraine Johnston Calhoun and one son Zachary Woods in 2020. Survivors include his wife of 23 years Angela Dodge Calhoun of Kuttawa, three sons Matthew T.
